

## MMC Adds E-Upgrades To Drug Free Partnership

We are pleased to announce that on January 1, 2019, Mobile Medical Corporation (MMC) will be launching new technology to enhance communication and scheduling procedures for participation in the Drug-Free program. This new technology is designed to deliver a faster and ultimately a more user-friendly experience for both the contractors and the members. The electronic upgrades will give members more flexibility when scheduling a test and quicker access to their drug free card. Cards will include a QR code that can be scanned using the QR scanner on your smart device.

The first phase of the member's e-upgrades will include three features.

**E-Portal:** An online dashboard to manage program information

E-Scheduler: An on-line notification system with a link to schedule a drug test

E-Card: A scannable drug free card equipped with a QR code

To begin members must register in the E-Portal located at MMC's web-site <a href="https://www.mobmed.com">www.mobmed.com</a> (click here.) The registration portal is where members will select preferred method of contact, email or text message, and confirm their demographics. Once registered, member will receive an email confirmation which includes a prompt to activate their account and links to the member dashboard login screen. Members can then login through the MMC website to view or make changes on the member dashboard. Members will then receive notifications for testing and drug free cards via the electronic method they have selected.



Contractors will also have new electronic capabilities with the E-upgrades. They will have the ability to verify a worker's eligibility by scanning the QR code on the members drug free card or the electronic version on a smart device. They will then be able to print a list of workers they have verified for the project. A phone App will be released with additional capabilities in the early part of 2019.
